Sample a desert you haven't tried yet!





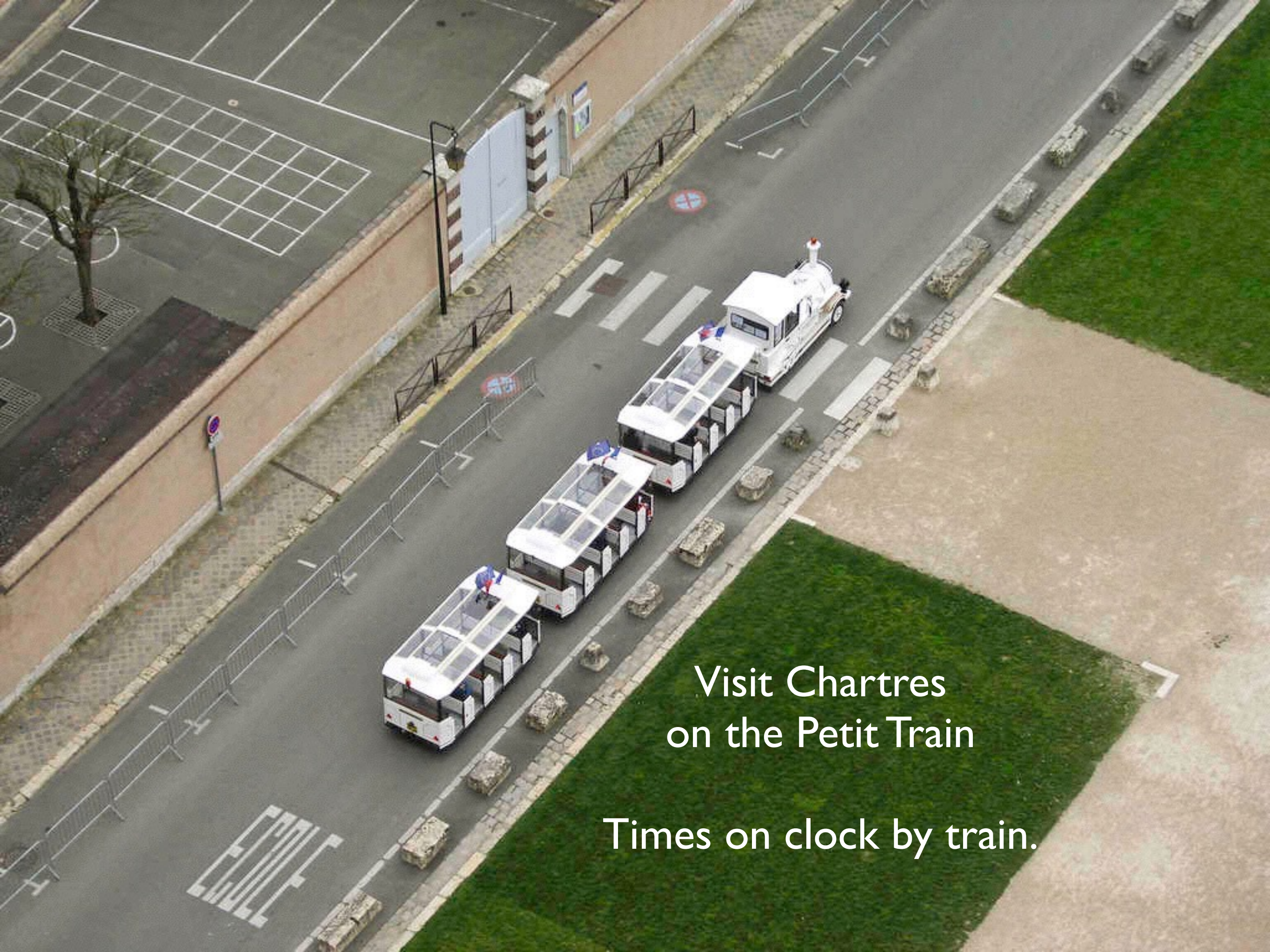
Take an audio tour

Small admission charge.



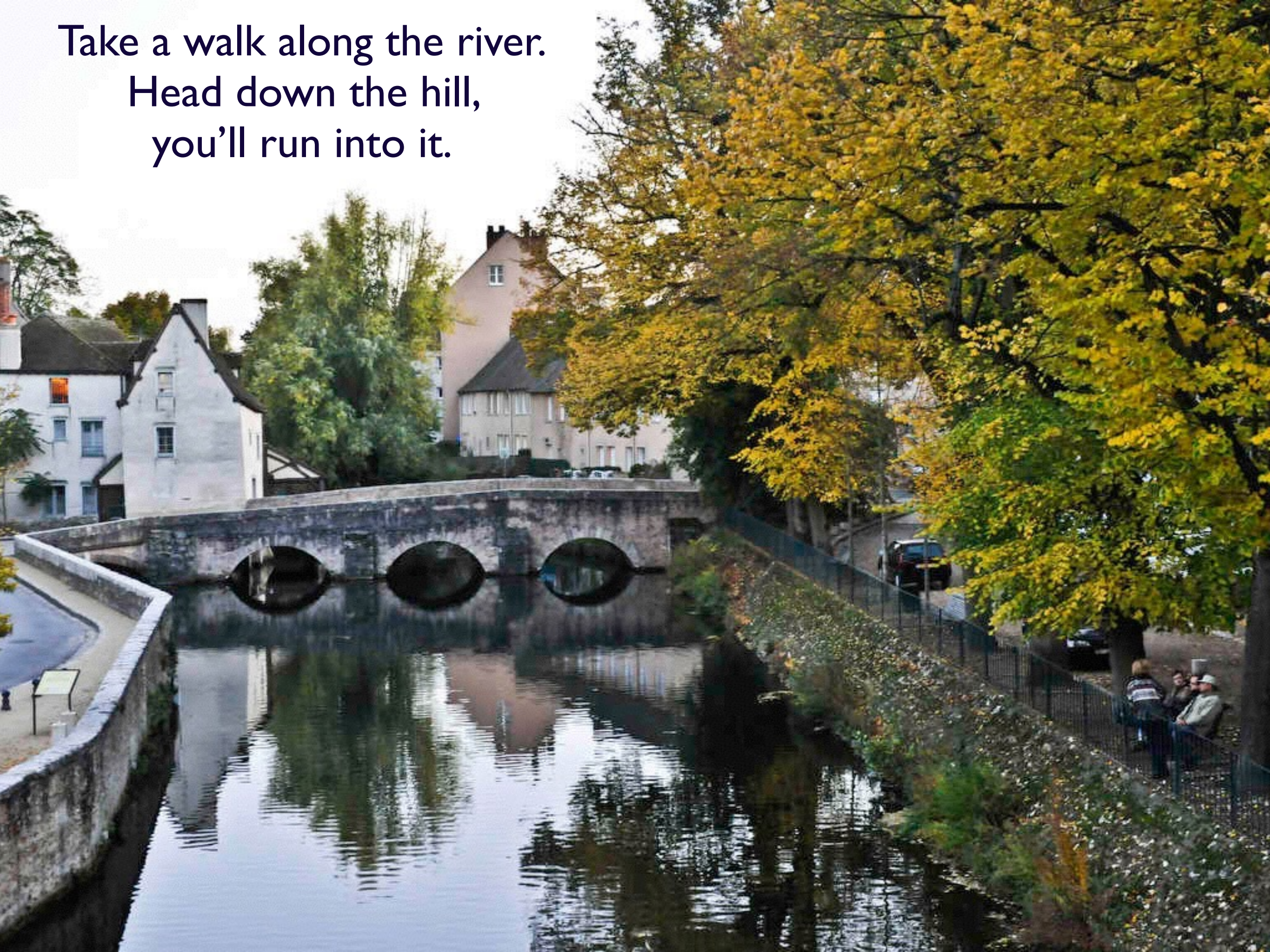
Visit Chartres
on the Petit Train

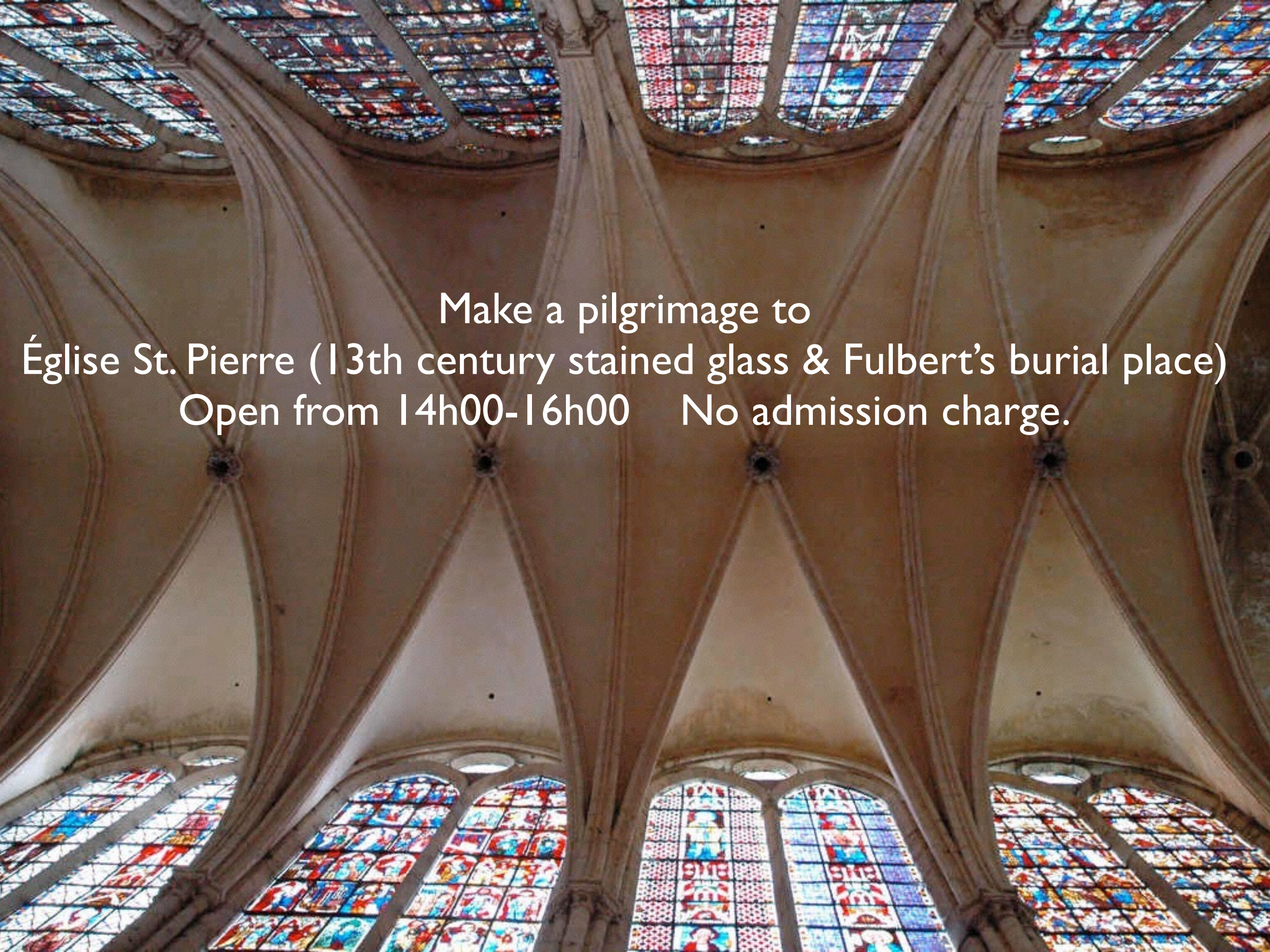
Times on clock by train.

Open from 14h00-16h00 No admission charge.

Walk in the Botanical Garden
(10-15 minute walk from centre ville)
Open all afternoon.
No admission charge.



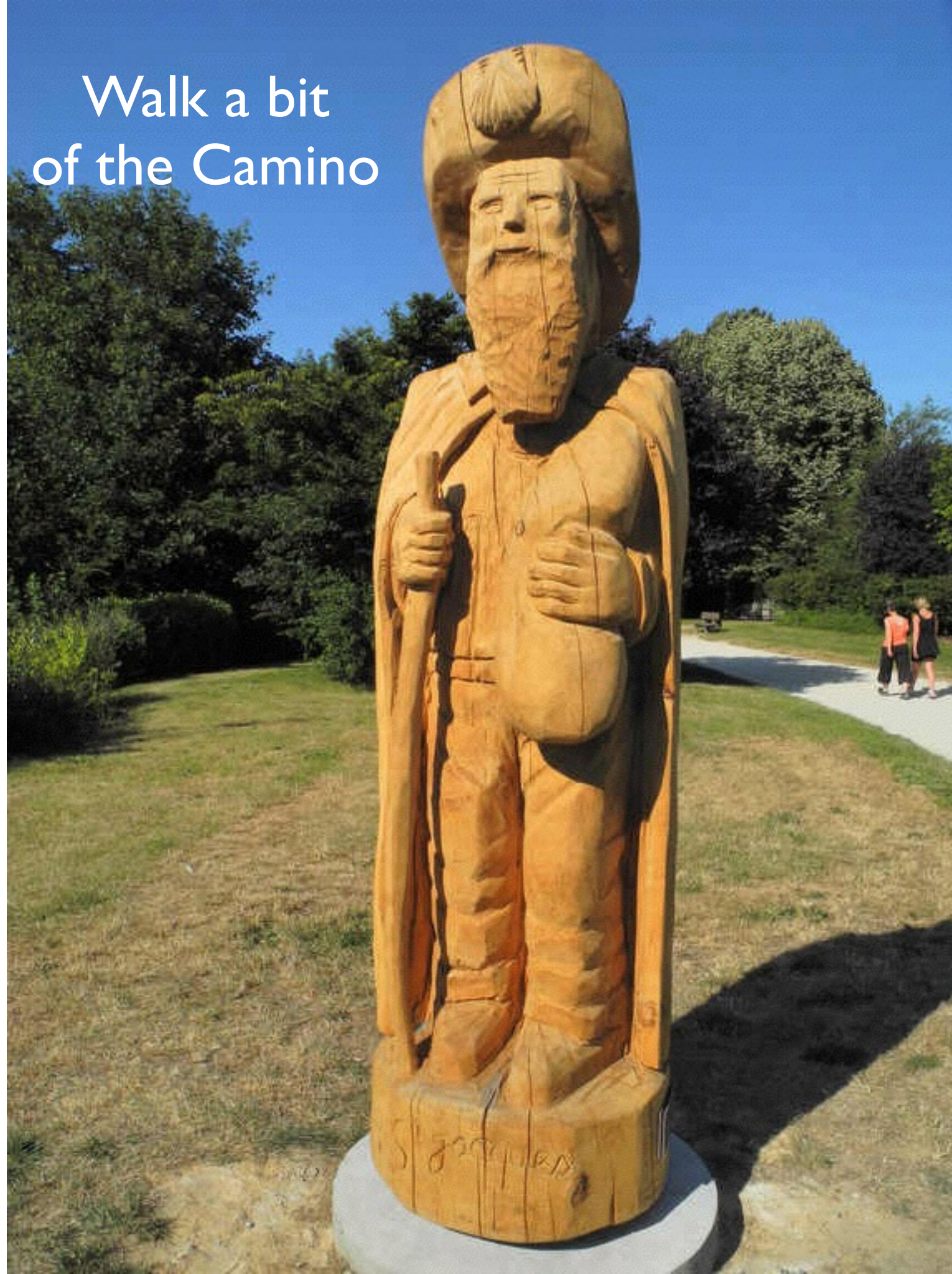


See Chartres from the water: Les Bords de l'Eure
